

Bundaberg Region's 2025 Australia Day Awards



Bundaberg Regional Council's Australia Day Awards recognise individuals and organisations who have made significant contributions to our region and achieved exceptional results in community service, sporting, creative, environmental and business endeavours.

Citizen of the Year

This award recognises an inspirational role model who displays ongoing excellence in their field and in the community, demonstrating leadership and innovation while contributing to or representing the Bundaberg Region.

Contributions can be made in any area that supports the advancement and wellbeing of the community in fields including, but not limited to, education, health, fundraising, charitable and voluntary services, business, sport, arts and the environment.

In choosing the recipients of the Bundaberg Region Australia Day Awards, regard is given to the nominee's achievements in the year immediately prior to receiving the award, as well as their past achievements and ongoing contribution to the community.

Nominations will be assessed across three key criteria:

- Significant contribution to the community and region
- An inspirational role model for the regional community
- · Demonstrated excellence in their field

Category eligibility:

- All nominees will be considered for the Citizen of the Year Award
- Nominees aged 25 years and under will also be considered for the Young Citizen of the Year Award
- Nominees aged 65 years and over will also be considered for the Senior Citizen of the Year Award
- Ages are as at 26 January of the awards year

Judging process:

Nominations will be reviewed by the appointed judging panel. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Eligibility criteria:

- Nominees must be Australian citizens and reside within the Bundaberg Regional Council area
- Awards will not be granted posthumously
- Self-nominations will not be accepted
- Unsuccessful nominees may be re-nominated in subsequent years
- Groups of people or couples will not normally be eligible though in exceptional cases the selection panel reserve the right to consider such nominations
- No weight is given to the number of times a person is nominated
