What's happening for the Fairymead Road Flood Evacuation Route?

Council is committed to updating the community on the flood mitigation projects within Bundaberg North. Further to Council's Community Newsletter No.1, a key milestone for this project was the finalisation of the detail design in late November. Programming is now underway for construction to commence in January 2015.

What's next?

Construction phase planning is well underway to ensure works are ready to commence early next year.

There will be minimal alterations to existing public utilities which will assist in smooth delivery of road & drainage works planned.

Council will continue to keep the community up to date as projects move forward.

The team will contact any potentially affected residents in the near future as the Fairymead Road Evacuation Route progresses.

We thank you for your ongoing patience while we deliver these important flood resilience projects.

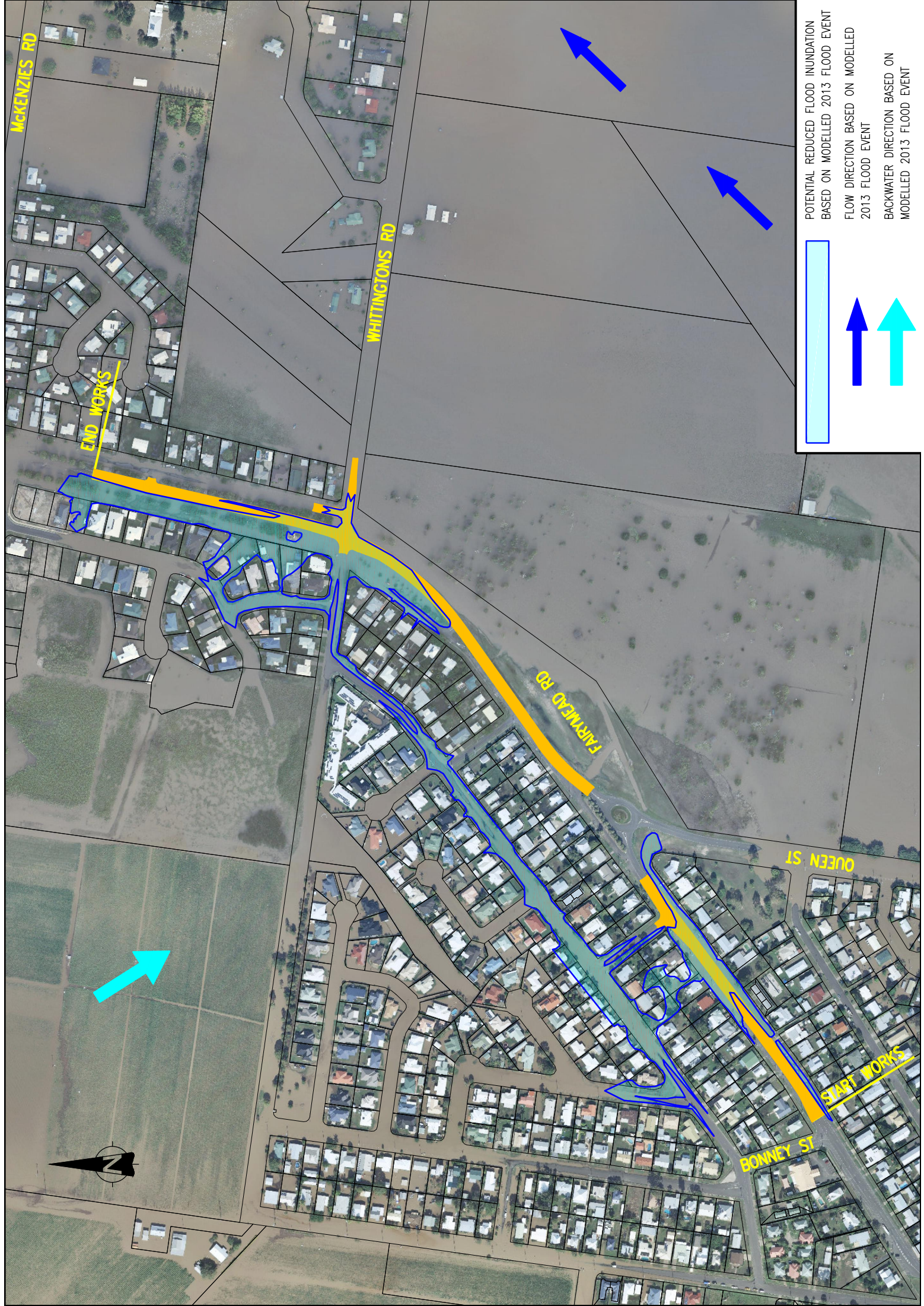
