

Branyan Street Culvert Improvements

Bundaberg Regional Council has appointed Downer Pipetech Pty Ltd as Principal Contractor to undertake culvert rehabilitation of the existing culvert on Branyan Street, Norville. The works will be undertaken as highlighted in red on the map above and will involve the installation of new precast pipework inserted into the existing pipes.

Works are planned to commence in late August 2024 with completion expected by early September 2024. Activities are expected to be carried out between the hours of 6:00 am and 6:00 pm Monday to Friday, with works on a Saturday and Sunday if required.

Works will be undertaken using traffic control and partial road closures. Access to private properties adjoining the work areas will be maintained during the construction period.

Residents can expect changes to traffic conditions during this time and delays may be experienced.

The Principal Contractor will provide suitable arrangements to maintain all regular services where these are provided, during the construction period.

Bundaberg Regional Council is aware of the inconvenience this work causes and thanks residents and road users in advance for their patience and co-operation.
