
Bin trial newsletter

Council has decided to end the FOGO Bundaberg Trial earlier than planned. Sufficient data has now been collected over the past four seasons.



How will the trial finish

Place bin out

Put your FOGO bin out the night before the last service day.

Leave on kerb

Keep the bin on the kerb until Council collects the empty bin after servicing.

Missed collection?

If you miss the last service, place the bin out the following week on the same day, and Council will return to collect it.

Post-trial

After this period, contact Council for a specific bin collection day. Council staff will be surveying the area to ensure all bins are retrieved.

Kitchen caddies

You can keep the provided kitchen caddies.

Final survey


A final survey is available for you to complete via the QR code.

Future regional FOGO service

At present Council has not decided to proceed with a permanent FOGO service. The trial data and survey results will help guide Council on the best approach for the community in the future. Over

600 tonnes of organics were

composted.

(66 garbage trucks)

51% less waste

was sent to landfill.



Less than 2% contamination in all FOGO material.

Bins were placed out for service

63% of the time.

Issues reported included flies, odour, excess liquid, bin cleaning issues and limited space due to fortnightly residual waste service.



Post-trial waste management

continue using your kitchen caddie for composting.



Use local garden bag services or self-haul green waste for free at Green Solutions Wide Bay or designated Council facilities.
