

Sewer System Upgrade

Hughes Road Sewage Infrastructure - Bargara

Issue No.1 - November 2024

What is happening?

With the housing developments occurring along Hughes Rd, Bargara, the revitalisation of the existing pump station will be undertaken to service the developing area.

Previously the Hughes Rd 'A' SPS (circled yellow in the adjacent photo) operated as a regional pump station for multiple stations. The current revitalisation will see it only collect sewage from the immediate area, greatly reducing the sewage retention time experienced in the past.

Impact from the works?

Traffic controls and detours will be employed during the construction phases of the project. To limit these impacts, construction will be scheduled to coincide with the road works being undertaken for the Hughes Road and Blain Street intersection.

Pedestrian accessibility past the station will also be affected during the construction phase.

What's the Benefits?

Revitalisation the existing sewer infrastructure was identified as the most sustainably and cost-effective strategy for the ongoing developments.
