Parks

Gin Gin Streetscape Playground South near the entrance to the town, will be receiving an upgrade in October and November. The upgrade will see the existing play equipment removed and replaced with nature play items including sandstone blocks, timber balance beams and steppers, Softfall, a garden bed and a small open grassed area. While this play space will be closed for safety reasons during the upgrade, the community can continue to access other play equipment in Gin Gin at Apex Park in Mulgrave Street, Kolan Community Park on Dear Street.
