

Flood Evacuation Route Fairymead Service Road East

Construction Works Update – May 2015

Project IRD1776.2014



This Update is to advise that construction works are about to commence on Fairymead Service Road East this month.

The works are part of the Fairymead Road Flood Evacuation Route project and will involve the reconstruction of the shallow drain along the Service Road. The driveways that traverse the drain will be upgraded with either a concrete or bitumen seal. Vehicle access to and within the service road will be maintained under traffic guidance. Vehicle access to properties are likely to be disrupted while construction works are in progress. Council staff will discuss any property restrictions with affected property owners.

Construction works will be generally carried out between the hours of 7.00 am and 5.00 pm. During the construction phase, there will be some noise and dust generated as part of the road construction process and Council will put control measures in place to minimise the impacts on local residents.

Bundaberg Regional Council is aware of the inconvenience construction work causes and thanks businesses, residents and road users in advance for their patience and co-operation.

Should your waste collection day fall while construction work is being undertaken on the road outside your property, would you please take your wheelie bin to the other side of the road.
